
Instructions for dice and card game

- 1. Choose a six word sentence from a book you have been reading with your child eg 'We're going on a bear hunt'
- 2. Print off four copies of the blank cards
- 3. Write the six words onto two of the card as in the example below, keep two of the cards as blank cards.

We're	going	on
a	bear	hunt

- 4. Cut the words into individual cards.
- 5. Write the six words on to the six sides of the dice, for example as in the one below



- 6. Fold and stick the dice template to make a 3D dice.
- 7. Spread the cards out on the floor or table.
- 8. Take turns throwing the dice with your child.
- 9. See if your child can match the word shown on the dice to one of the cards.
- 10. Read the word together. After reading the card the player takes the card.
- 11. If a player already has a word they throw again.
- 12. Repeat, taking turns until one player has 6 cards with the different words.
- 13. Arrange together to make a sentence.
- 14. Read the sentence together.
- 15. Look back at the book and find the sentence in the story.
